By registering for and/or participating in 2025 Lions Tour Official Golf Day, you agree to the following Terms & Conditions:

1. Eligibility

- The event is open to participants who have registered and are aged 18 years and over.
- Participants must have a basic understanding of golf rules and etiquette.

2. Registration

- Registration is subject to availability. Numbers are limited.

3. Health & Safety

- Participants confirm they are in good physical health and capable of participating in a round of golf.
- All players must comply with the venue rules and guidelines at <u>Know the Rules and Etiquette | Kooyonga Golf Club</u> and any instructions given by marshals or event staff.
- Participants must wear appropriate golf attire and footwear and comply with the venue dress code (<u>Dress Code - Kooyonga Golf Club</u>). Shoes must be golf appropriate. Socks must be white if wearing shorts and visible above the shoe line. Denim, hoodies and t-shirts without collars are prohibited. Tattoos must be covered.

4. Liability

- Rugby Australia and STH Group accept no responsibility for any injuries, loss, or damage incurred during the event, except in cases of proven negligence.
- Participants are responsible for their own personal belongings for the duration of the event.

5. Conduct

- All participants are expected to behave in a respectful and sportsmanlike manner.
- Any inappropriate behaviour, including intoxication or misuse of facilities, may result in removal from the event.

6. Weather & Course Conditions

- The event will proceed in most weather conditions, unless the golf course management deems it unsafe. If this is the case, event organisers will advise the Lead Booker as soon as is possible.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel or modify the Event in response to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
